A short interview with ITC's Internship coordinator was also shared to provide insights on the event and what the company expects from the students to start an internship.

"Ofcourse it is important that you have the required skills and knowledge to do the real assignment but further what they are looking for are students that are really proactive and are motivated and committed so you are expected to really act like an employee when you start with your job after your graduation. So, we do ask for a very professional attitude and I think our ITC students are well equipped to do that. 
MR ANDRE DA SILVA



The faculty ITC does not provide financial support for internships. The internship coordinator facilitates the set-up of an internship and the contractual agreements. Expense reimbursements or any salaries offered by the internship host are based on personal agreements between the student and the internship host (Taken from Internship - Canvas page)

• Is there any financial support available while doing the internship in the Netherlands?

The financial support depends on the agreement between the student and the organization. Usually, organizations do not pay for internships, but this is very much dependent.

• How can I financially support myself if I am doing an internship abroad?

There is always a possibility that you are eligible for a scholarship in case of an internship abroad. The list of internship can be found here: https://www.utwente.nl/en/study-abroad/internship/.

Please note that it is not a guarantee that you would get the scholarship. Make sure you have an alternative plan to finance your internship just in case.
