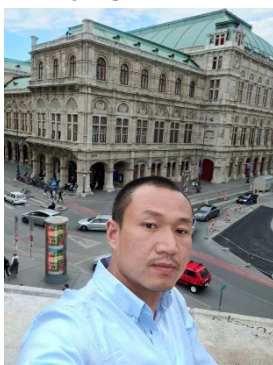


### **Gerard Martínez Görbig**
